# READ:

Exodus 12, Matthew 26:26-30, Mark 14:12-26 and Luke 22:14-23

## Scripture:

"This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."

Luke 22:20



The Passover Supper was a meal that celebrated the covenant that God made with His people to deliver them from bondage and into His glory. Once the Israelites came out of Egypt, God told Moses to do this as a memorial to Him. For 1,600 years the Israelites celebrated this redemptive event, but Jesus came to fulfill it. Do you see the relation to the two stories?

- A) The Israelites were slaves in Egypt and we were slaves to sin.
- B) The blood of the lamb was put on the door post to save the child from death and the blood of Jesus is what saves us from sin.
- C) Death could not enter were the blood was poured and we will experience eternal life because of His blood.

So when we ask Jesus to forgive us of our sins and be Lord and Savior of our life, we are entering a covenant with Him that gives us eternal life.

# READ:

Matthew 26:36-46

Communication with God is prayer. Moses communicated with God on Mount Sinai and God revealed His glory to Moses. In order for us to experience His glory we must be actively seeking God through prayer.

In this passage, Jesus is getting ready to offer His life as a sacrifice. We see a glimpse of Jesus' prayer and what He was preparing to do. Jesus' death was God's glory revealed to us because this was God's plan all along, for us to have a redemptive relationship with Him. A relationship requires communication between two people. Often times when we pray, we do all of the talking and not enough listening. God is wanting to speak to us. After you read your prayer challenge for the day, come back and write down your experience.

## Prayer Time:

Today, spend time listening for God to speak. It's easy to be distracted and get lost in thought. Turn on some music, grab your bible, get paper and a pencil and as you read the Bible, ask God what He wants to speak to you today.

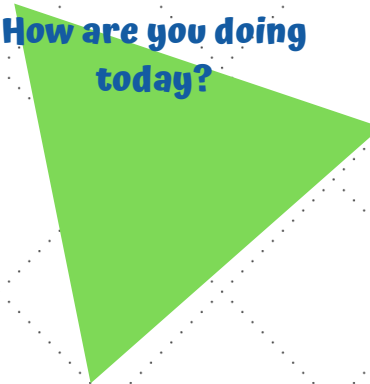
## Prayer Time:
