Primary Function:

- 1. To support, equip and lead the kids ministry at The Potter's House.
- 2. Maintain, and improve upon, systems and operations with a standard of excellence within the kids ministry.
- 3. Develop a dynamic leadership team through providing resources and training and implementing appreciation strategies.
- 4. Facilitate a kids ministry in such a way that children are experiencing a move of God, and learning the character and nature of the Holy Spirit.
- 5. Provide oversight to the PH Kids Nursery and Preschool Director, PH Kids Check-in, and when necessary, the Childcare Coordinator.
- 6. Lead the efforts to help families and kids grow in faith and community, as well as provide a path to wholeness for children in your care.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Plan, lead and execute services in PH Kids.
- 2. Provide spiritual care to the kids, PH Kids Team members and others as needed.
- 3. Recruit and train new PH Kids Team members, running and maintaining background checks, and implement standardized training for all members.
- 4. Select curriculum that will create a systematic path to wholeness for elementary and preschool aged children.
- 5. Resolve problems in services with children, parents and team members.
- 6. Provide at least one spiritual conference, or retreat per year, and quarterly events for the purpose of building community.
- 7. Lead and oversee the planning and execution of VBS, and any PH Kids Conference that may happen throughout the year.
- 8. Propose an annual budget and oversee the finances of the kids ministry.
- 9. Create tracking and follow up systems to connect to new kids and families.
- 10. Create a system for assimilation and provide family type resources for families with children.
- 11. Create and manage the team schedule on a monthly basis for all Potter's House church services, and special events when needed.
- 12. Implement monthly team communications strategy and minimum of one in-person team wide training a year.
- 13. Provide a plan for growth from Preschool, through Elementary, and working in conjunction with the Student Life Pastor on PHJV.
- 14. Provide vision, resources and communication to campus Kids Pastors.

Practical Expectations

- 1. Live a Christ centered, healthy and integrous life at church, work and home.
- 2. Strong personal relationship with Jesus Christ as evidenced by spiritual maturity and a close consistent walk with Him
- 3. Have a commitment to The Potter's House vision, as well as an understanding of and willingness to serve within the values of the church.
- 4. Church attendance at all Potter's House Columbus services, church wide events and staff meetings.
- 5. Approval for Sunday ministry in and outside of Potter's House campuses.
- 6. Be teachable and willing to learn and grow in your craft.
- 7. Be available to fellowship with and minister to families and attendees of the church.
- 8. Regularly pray for and encourage wholeness in the lives of the PH Kids team and children.
- 9. Provide leadership and carry out needs for PH Kids in church wide events and special services.
